

Vinyl Application Instructions

Step 1:

Make sure the surface is clean and dry. For best results, prep with Rubbing Alcohol. ****Do NOT use Rubbing Alcohol on The Container Store Birch Clips. It may remove the finish****

Step 2:

Carefully remove the backing paper, leaving only the label and transfer tape. ****Heat during shipping may cause the label to stick to the backing. Simply flip the label face-down and rub a credit card over the label to make sure it adheres to the transfer tape.**

Step 3:

Once your sticker is positioned correctly you can press the transfer tape onto a surface to adhere it. Next, use a credit card to apply pressure to the entire design to make sure it's fully adhered. Always make sure to start from the center and work out towards the edges, this will press out any bubbles instead of pushing them in.

Step 4:

Once you have your vinyl securely adhered to the surface, take one corner of your transfer tape and SLOWLY pull downwards at a 180 degree angle.

If your design is especially delicate, let it sit for 24 hours before removing the transfer tape. This gives your sticker time to adhere more strongly to the surface and makes it easier to remove the tape while leaving the design intact.

Vinyl Care

This Joyful House uses premium outdoor vinyl that is waterproof and weather resistant. However, gently hand wash items for best results. Do not scrub.
